**All bowling will be done using the exciting 'BAKER' style format!
The baker style uses all 5 players scoring in the same game.
(The leadoff bowler rolls frames one and six, the 2nd bowler rolls frames two and seven, etc.)**

QUALIFYING COMPETITION

All teams will bowl 12 games. Lane assignment will be made by lottery draw. Teams will bowl 1st game on drawn lane, 2nd game on alternate lane of the pair. Teams will move left of right 3 pairs of lanes for successive pairs of games. (Odd starting lanes will move left, even starting lanes will move right.)

MATCH PLAY COMPETITION

Top 8 teams based on total pinfall will advance to Match Play Competition. The Qualifying Competition score will be carried forward. Teams will be assigned numbers 1 thru 8 based on Qualifying Competition score. Two game matches will be bowled against each opponent plus a final position round. 15 Bonus points will be awarded for each game won. 20 Bonus points will be awarded for each match won. Bonus points will be divided equally in the event of a tie.

TITLE PLAY COMPETITION

The top 3 teams based on total score (Qualifying, Match Play and Bonus Points) shall advance to the Title Play. The three finalists will bowl two game matches. Total pinfall of the matches will determine the winner.

SEMI-FINAL MATCH – Third place team bowls the second place team. The winner will advance to the Final Match. Loser receives third place prize.

TITLE MATCH – Winner of the Semi-Final match bowls the tournament leader. Winner receives Champions awards, Loser receives 2nd place prize.

14TH ANNUAL ST PAUL "OPEN" TEAM CHALLENGE

1. This tournament is open to all St Paul USBC members only.
Non USBC members will purchase USBC Associate memberships - \$16.00
Non St Paul USBC will purchase an Association Only Membership - \$5.00
2. Entrants may participate with only one team in the tournament.
3. All prize fees will be returned 100% on a 1 for 3 ratio.
4. The captain may replace any player with a qualified substitute at any time. A player removed during a game cannot return to bowl in the same game. Lineups may be changed at the completion of any game.
5. Team lineups are limited to seven (7) players.
Final Team Lineups must be submitted at check-in time.
Replacements in team lineups are allowed ONLY by approval of Tournament Management.
6. If a tie exists to determine 8th place at the conclusion of Qualifying Competition, teams will bowl an additional game to break the tie.

If a tie still exists, a ninth and tenth frame roll-off will be bowled until the tie is broken.

7. In the event of a tie, to determine positions one thru seven for placement in the Match Play Competition, the last Qualifying game bowled will be used to break the tie.
If a tie exists for that game, previous game scores will be used until a tie breaking score is found.
8. If a tie occurs during the Title Play, a five frame roll-off will be bowled, scored as frames six thru ten, until the tie is broken.
9. Tournament Management will determine the lanes to be used for all competition (scheduled and/or tie breaking).
All tie breaking competition WILL NOT be included in total pinfall.

All Bowlers must be members of the St. Paul USBC Association.

AVERAGES

Bowlers must use highest USBC standard or adjusted sport league average for the 2006-2007 winter season (21 games or more in one league). Bowlers not having an established 2006-2007 winter average, may use their highest 2007 spring / summer average.

Bowlers with no previous season average shall use their current average as of 1st date of bowling. (21 games or more in one league) All others will bowl scratch.

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others.

In the case of a team of 2 or more bowlers, the averages shall be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total.

If their submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.

Corrections in average can be made up to the end of the 1st game of the series, or within 48 hours after the end of a series if the tournament manager, prior to the finish of the 1st game of the series, has given consent authorizing such extension.

AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT

10-pin average increase rule WILL be in effect.

Winnings of \$600 or more in any tournament in the past 12 months, must be reported at time of entry

Re-rating Rule 319e shall apply to all bowlers
If a bowler's accumulated tournament average, during the past 12 months for all, but not less than 21 games, exceeds the entering average by 15 or more pins, the accumulated tournament average must be used.

PARTICIPATION

Team Event – Multiple Entries Allowed with a Change of Two Players.

Doubles Event – Entry Limited to One Time.

Opt. Singles – Multiple Entries Allowed - Cash Once.
(Individual Team Score with Handicap)

Opt. All Events – Entry Limited to One Time.
(1st Team Score & Doubles Score with Handicap)

PRIZE PAYOFF

All Prize Money Returned 100%.

Prorated on number of entries.

Payback Ratios

Handicap Team, Doubles and Singles - 1 for 4

Optional Scratch Team, Doubles - 1 for 6

Optional All Events - 1 for 10

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Scratch: Team - 840, Doubles - 420

Opt. Singles & All Events - 210

Handicap: 90% – No Limit.

FORFEITURES

Bowlers failing to appear at scheduled time will forfeit all money unless they can be rescheduled.

Bowlers arriving late will receive 0 for all frames missed.

Forfeiture of entry fees and prizes will follow disclosure of any violation of USBC tournament rules.

BRACKETS

Handicapped Brackets will be conducted each shift.

Proceeds used for Champions Awards, Banquet of Champions Dinners and to offset expenses.
