

# **ST. PAUL YABA BOWLING ASSOCIATION**

The Association's First Officers elected were:

President – Marcella Witwicke; Vice President – Ed Kurhajetz; Sect-Treas – Emery Engebretson.

The first City Tournament Team Event was scheduled to be conducted on November 7, 1964 at Maplewood Bowl. The event would be a "kick-off" to the Women's Championship.

The first Doubles and Singles Event was scheduled to be held on December 23, 28, 29, 30, 1964 with the boys competing at North Star Lanes and the girls at White Bear Bowl.
