

ST. PAUL BOWLING ASSOCIATION

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The St. Paul Bowling Association has established a scholarship program to further interest in youth bowling, foster a desire for better education for our youth, give youth bowlers an incentive to maintain their amateur status and help enhance the image of the sport.

1. Eligibility - All YABA sanctioned youth bowlers, age 14 through 21, bowling at a center from within the jurisdiction of the St. Paul Junior Bowling Association, are eligible to apply. The bowler's age shall be as of August 1 of the current bowling season. A bowler may only win two scholarships.

2. Scholarships - At least two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to youth bowlers from within the St. Paul Junior Bowling Association. The scholarship winners will be determined by considering an applicant's involvement in leadership and community activities, performance in school and participation in extracurricular activities and the writing of an essay.

3. Award Process - Scholarship certificates will be awarded at the St. Paul Association Champions Banquet in May. The scholarship money will be held in escrow at an approved financial institution. The scholarship money must be used within four years after the date of the award or within four years after graduation from high school, whichever comes later. The scholarship money must be paid directly to the school of the recipient's choice after enrollment has been confirmed.

4. Board of Trustees - The Board of Trustees for the scholarship program shall consist of the President and Secretary of the St. Paul Junior Bowling Association and one representative each from the St. Paul Men's and Women's Bowling Associations. The Board of Trustees shall appoint a three member panel to review the scholarship applications and determine the winners.

5. Source of Funds - The St. Paul Bowling Associations will raise scholarship funds by holding a fund raising dinner in conjunction with a raffle and by conducting brackets at various City Tournaments.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

Eligibility Rules :

1. Applicant must be a YABA sanctioned bowler from a bowling center within the jurisdiction of the St. Paul Junior Bowling Association.
2. Applicant must be age 14 through 21 as of August 1 of the current bowling season.
3. Applicant must complete all application forms and return them by March 31.

Application Procedure :

1. Fill out Application Form completely.
2. Use the Essay Form to write an essay of at least 100 words, stating your institution for career advancement and future plans. Judging of the essay will be based on the inclusion of specific plans, clarity, organization and logic. You may attach a typed essay to the Essay Form.
3. Give your league coach :
 - (a) the completed Application Form,
 - (b) the completed Essay Form,
 - (c) the Coach's Evaluation Form to be filled out by the coach and
 - (d) a stamped envelope addressed to Thomas Kieger
286 Lion Lane Shoreview, MN 55126.
4. Ask your coach to fill in the Coach's Evaluation Form completely and to mail all three forms above to Thomas Kieger before March 31.
5. Give the School Official or Counselor's Evaluation Form to one of your teachers or to your school counselor along with a stamped envelope addressed to Thomas Kieger. Ask your teacher or counselor to fill in the form completely and mail it before March 31. If you are not currently in school, give this form to an official at the school you last attended.
6. Check with your league coach and teacher or counselor by March 30 to be sure all the application forms have been mailed. Thank them for their help.
